Objective: The student will 1. Independently approach a student (walk towards or stand at proximity of 3 – 5 feet), 2. Make eye contact with the student 3. Initiate greeting to peers by saying, “hi, [name],” or using a similar greeting phrase *asking students name if unknown should also be counted as correct.	Targeted Not Yet

Objective: When presented with the following game, the student will state the name of the missing child: students sit in a circle and close their eyes. Request and Give: Art Activity

Objective: During an art type of activity in which students will be using the same materials/items to complete an independent activity (such as drawing or coloring with markers at the same table), the student will gain a peer’s attention (by saying the peer’s name and/or making eye contact) and use a full sentence to request an item from the peer at a rate of 1 request per minute, and will give a requested item to a peer in 80% of opportunities across 2 consecutive sessions. Request and Give: Expansion Skill 1

Objective: Student will say, “in a minute” or “when I’m done” within 5 seconds of a request (and will give the requested item after a minute has passed or when done using the item) in 60% of opportunities across 2 consecutive sessions. The student will refrain from engaging in any inappropriate behavior while waiting for an item, and will use a taught strategy (such as picking a different item to use or doing something different while waiting for an item, and will use a taught strategy) in 100% of opportunities across 2 consecutive sessions.
